Course	Overview	This course focuses on intensively enhancing Chinese character, kanji, vocabulary skills at the beginner to lower-intermediate level.

【Objectives and goals of each subject】

Development of Kanji Vocabulary ①	RFJ: A1 JLPT: N5-N4 [Introductory Level to Beginner]	The goal of this subject is to acquire strategies for learning kanji in the introductory stage and obtain fundamental kanji vocabulary and writing skills. The learning objectives include mastering the meanings and readings of kanji vocabulary at the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N5 and N4 level covered in the beginner-level main textbook and mastering the writings of N5 and N4 level kanji correctly by using Takushoku University's unique K-Code learning method.
Development of Kanji Vocabulary ②	RFJ: A2-B1 JLPT: N4-N3 [Beginner to Lower-Intermediate]	The goal of this subject is to obtain basic kanji vocabulary used in everyday situations. The learning objectives include mastering the meanings, readings, and writings of kanji at the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N4 and N3 level as covered in beginner to lower-intermediate textbooks, and further developing the ability to recognize and understand the readings and meanings of N3-level kanji vocabulary.

Course Title	Japanese Language Practice II
Course Overview	This course focuses on intensively enhancing character vocabulary skills according to the learners' proficiency levels.

Development of Character Vocabulary Skills ①	RFJ: A2- JLPT: N4-N3 [Beginner to Lower-Intermediate]	The goal of this subject is to acquire linguistic knowledge at the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N3 level, including characters, vocabulary, and grammar necessary for reading and understanding concrete texts on everyday topics. The learning objectives include mastering grammatical and syntactic structures, commonly used kanji, and vocabulary required to handle such contents.
Development of Character Vocabulary Skills ②	RFJ: A2-B1 JLPT: N3-N2 [ Lower-Intermediate to Intermediate]	The goal of this subject is to prepare for acquiring linguistic knowledge at the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N2 level, including characters, vocabulary, and grammar necessary for reading newspapers, commentaries, and plain critiques, as well as for listening to news and discussions in addition to everyday situations. The learning objectives include mastering grammatical and syntactic structures, commonly used kanji, and vocabulary required to handle such contents.
Development of Character Vocabulary Skills ③	RFJ: B1 - JLPT: N3 – [Intermediate or higher]	The goal of this subject is to acquire linguistic knowledge at the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N2 level, including characters, vocabulary, and grammar necessary for reading newspapers, commentaries, and plain critiques, as well as for listening to news and discussions in addition to everyday situations. The learning objectives include mastering grammatical and syntactic structures, approximately 1,000 commonly used kanji, and 7,000 vocabulary words required to handle such contents.
Development of Character Vocabulary Skills ④	RFJ: B2 - JLPT: N2 - [Upper-Intermediate or higher]	The goal is to acquire linguistic knowledge at the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N1 level, including characters, vocabulary, and grammar necessary for reading newspapers, critiques, and editorials, as well as for listening to news and lectures about a wide range of topics. The learning objectives include mastering the grammatical and syntactic structures, approximately 2,000 commonly used kanji, and 10,000 vocabulary words required to handle such contents.

Course	Title	Japanese Language Practice III
Course	Overview	This course focuses on intensively enhancing oral expression skills according to the learners' proficiency levels.

【Objectives and goals of each subject】

Name of the subject	Reference Level / Target RFJ JLPT	Objectives and Goals
Development of oral communication skills ①	RFJ: A1-A2 JLPT: N5-N4 [Introductory Level to Lower-Intermediate]	The objective of this subject is to acquire conversational skills based on mastering natural Japanese pronunciation, particularly prosody. The learning objectives include developing the ability to communicate with natural Japanese pronunciation in common daily situations, both inside and outside the classroom through practicing everyday conversations and delivering short speeches at a natural speed.
Development of oral communication skills ②	RFJ: B1-B2 JLPT: N3-N2 [Intermediate to Upper-Intermediate]	The objective of this subject is to develop an ability to give clear and detailed explanations on a wide range of topics related to areas of personal interest and concern, as well as to explain current events by presenting points in favor and against them. The learning objectives include improving oral expression skills through repeated practice of presentations in class and enhancing the ability to be able to hold discussions and give presentations after entering universities and other institutions.
Development of oral communication skills ③	RFJ: B2- JLPT: N2- [Upper-Intermediate to higher]	The objective of this subject is to develop an ability to discuss complex topics in depth, including related subtopics, and to summarize discussions with appropriate conclusions. The learning objectives include improving oral expression skills through repeated practice of presentations in class and enhancing the ability to be able to discuss and present social issues and one's own specialized field after entering university or graduate school.

Course Title	Japanese Language Practice IV
Course Overview	This course focuses on enhancing Japanese language skills according to the learners' academic and other goals.

【Objectives and goals of each subject】

Name of the subject	Reference Level / Target RFJ JLPT	Objectives and Goals
Development of Japanese Language Skill①	RFJ: A1-B1 JLPT: N5-N3 [Beginner to Intermediate]	The goal of this subject is to acquire IT literacy through learning basic computer operations. The learning objectives include improving skills in inputting Japanese on IT devices with a Japanese-language environment, searching for information in Japanese, and creating emails, documents, and PowerPoint presentations in Japanese, thereby developing abilities useful for the future career paths.
Development of Japanese Language Skill②	RFJ: B1 - JLPT: N3 - [Intermediate or higher]	The goal of this subject is to acquire the Japanese language skills necessary for entering an undergraduate program and engaging in self-directed learning. The learning objectives include developing abilities to be able to prepare application documents, such as admission forms for the desired university, respond to the "writing" section of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU), use appropriate structures, vocabulary, and expressions suitable for higher education, and present supporting evidence for arguments and conclusions while considering multiple perspectives.
Development of Japanese Language Skill③	RFJ: B1 - JLPT: N2 - [Intermediate or higher]	The goal of this subject is to acquire the knowledge and practical Japanese communication skills required for job hunting in Japan. The learning objectives include mastering basic business etiquette, communication skills in polite language (keigo) in job interviews and common workplace situations, and writing skills in formal documents such as resumes and emails with appropriate formatting and expressions.

Course	Title	Japanese Language Practice V
Course	Overview	This course focuses on firmly acquiring grammar knowledge appropriate to each proficiency level and enhancing the ability to apply it in practical use.

Development of Sentence Pattern Application Skills ①	RFJ: A1-A2 JLPT: N5-N4 [Beginner to Lower-Intermediate]	The goal is to firmly acquire and be able to use basic-level Japanese grammar. The learning objectives include mastering the grammar knowledge necessary to pass the JLPT N4 and developing an ability to use learned sentence patterns and expressions to engage in simple daily conversations, understand basic information, and write short sentences.
Development of Sentence Pattern Application Skills ②	RFJ: A1-B2 JLPT: N4-N2 [Lower-Intermediate to Intermediate]	The goal of this subject is to firmly acquire and master intermediate-level Japanese grammar. The learning objectives include mastering the grammar knowledge necessary to pass the JLPT N3 and developing the ability to use learned sentence patterns and expressions in output activities such as conversations, writing, and presentations to express oneself in one's own words.
Development of Sentence Pattern Application Skills ③	RFJ: B1-C1 JLPT: N3-N1 [Upper-Intermediate to Advanced]	The goal of this subject is to firmly acquire and master advanced-level Japanese grammar. The learning objectives include mastering the grammar knowledge necessary to pass the JLPT N2/N1 and developing the ability to effectively use learned sentence patterns and expressions in output activities such as conversations, writing, and presentations at a high level.

Course Title	Japanese Language Practice VI
Course Overview	This course focuses on enhancing writing skills for academic or other purposes.

【Objectives and goals of each subject】

Name of the subject	Reference Level / Target RFJ JLPT	Objectives and Goals
Development of Writing Skills①	RFJ: A1-B1 JLPT: N5-N3 [Beginner to Lower-Intermediate]	The goal of this subject is to acquire basic computer writing literacy and enhance communication skills through essential writing activities in daily life. The learning objectives include developing the ability to be able to fill out essential documents with ease and to write about familiar topics or personal interests using a computer, while engaging in activities such as writing essential documents, letters, résumés, and social media posts in daily life, and creating and presenting PowerPoint slides.
Development of Writing Skills②	RFJ: B1 - JLPT: N3 - [Intermediate or higher / Students wishing to enter university]	The goal of this subject is for students who wish to enter universities to acquire their Japanese language skills necessary to be admitted to a university and to enhance their ability to search for information and write logical sentences. The learning objectives include improving students' overall Japanese language skills to keep up with classes after entering a university, while preparing a statement of reasons for applying for admission and an application form and practicing for interviews.
Development of Writing Skills③	RFJ: B1-C1 JLPT: N3-N1 [Upper-Intermediate to Advanced]	This goal of this subject is for students who wish to enter graduate school to improve their logical Japanese language skills necessary for research and communication skills required for life in graduate school. The learning objectives include developing abilities to understand advanced Japanese used in graduate school, gather information on one's research and specialty, organize a research plan and statement of purpose in a logical manner, and communicate their own thoughts orally.
